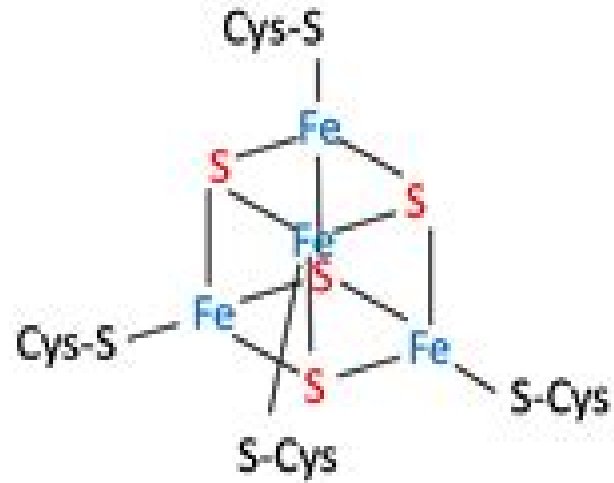
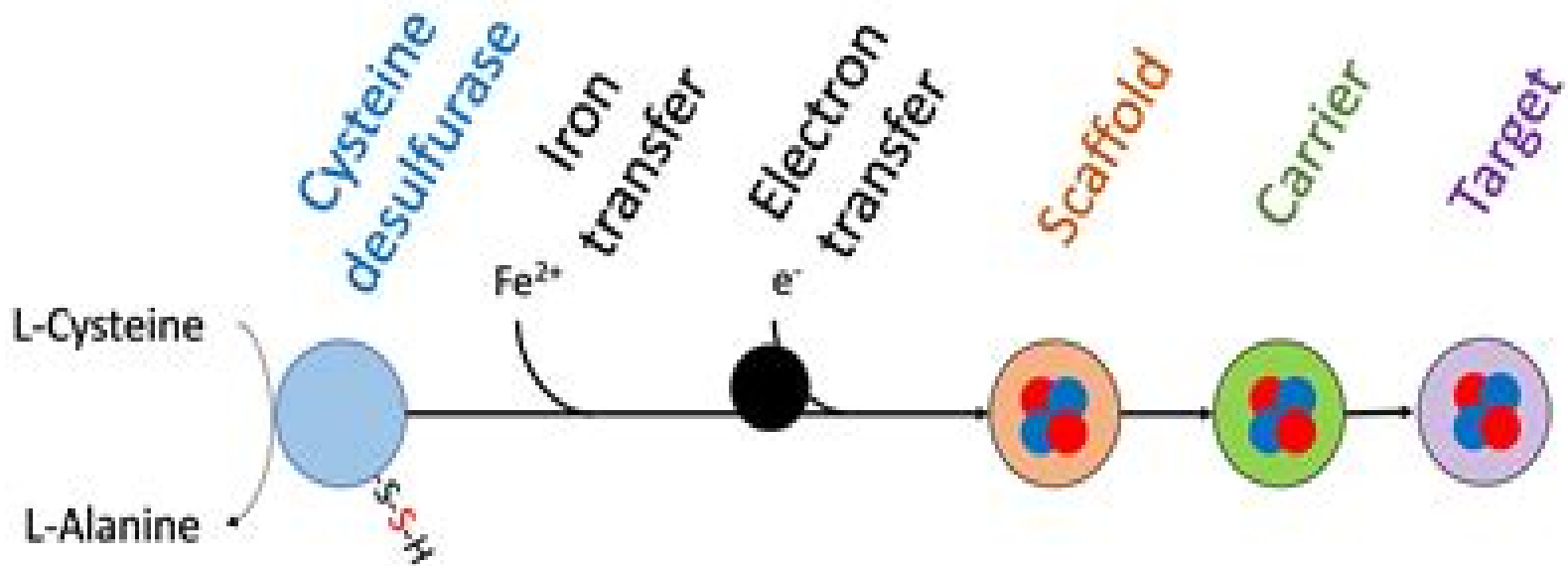

Iron-sulfur Cluster Biosynthesis. Iron-sulfur Cluster Transfer from Holo ISU and ISA to Apo Ferredoxin Shu-Pao Wu, 2004
Abstract The processes of iron sulfur cluster transfer from holo ISU and ISA to apo Fd were studied Direct cluster transfer from holo ISU to apo Fd was demonstrated by Mossbauer spectroscopy Experimental data shows that an intact 2Fe 2S core is transferred to target proteins Substitution of a key aspartate residue Asp 37 of ISU is found to decrease the rate of cluster transfer by at least an order of magnitude The rate constants of cluster transfer from native ISA to Fd are shown to be similar to those of cluster transfer from Cys derivatives of ISA The factors that contribute to cluster transfer efficiency also appear to be similar including the importance of cluster lability and solvent accessibility Both ISA and ISU mediated Fe S cluster transfer to apo Fd have been shown to be pH dependent The pKa of ISA is 7.8 slightly higher than the value of 6.9 found for ISU This is consistent with deprotonation of a solvent accessible cysteine which would thereby provide a more effective nucleophilic center for facilitating cluster transfer to apo Fd Viscosity studies show that diffusion is not the rate limiting step which is most likely the process of Fe S cluster transfer between the intermediate complexes ISU Fd and ISA Fd The influences of the binding of DnaK to IscU were studied DnaK can maintain a stable structure of ferric ion bound IscU and avoids aggregation triggered by ferric ions Also DnaK bound IscU has more stable iron sulfur clusters Kinetic studies of Fe S cluster transfer from holo IscU to apo Fd in the presence of DnaK reveal that the binding of DnaK to IscU slows down the rate of Fe S cluster transfer from IscU especially formation of IscU Fd complexes Binding of DnaK decreases the rates of forming IscU Fd complexes greater than 8 fold and also causes a minor change on the rates of iron sulfur cluster transfer in IscU Fd complexes In other words binding of DnaK to IscU does not facilitate the process of Fe S cluster transfer from IscU

Structural Insight Into the Assembly of Iron-sulfur Clusters and Their Function in Radical Generation Jessica Lynn Vey, 2008 This thesis addresses two emerging areas in the study of iron sulfur cluster biochemistry bioassembly of iron sulfur clusters and their involvement in initiation of radical chemistry The structure of a cysteine desulfurase involved in cluster bioassembly in the cyanobacterium *Synechocystis* PCC sp 6803 was solved by X ray crystallography and analyzed in terms of its mechanistic implications We found that the active site cysteine responsible for the direct removal of sulfur from substrate cysteine is located on a short well ordered loop consistent with structures solved of homologous proteins The length of this loop is thought to restrain the active site cysteine interfering with its ability to affect catalysis Our results are consistent with the theory that this cysteine desulfurase requires an accessory protein for fully activity in vivo Two structures of pyruvate formate lyase activating enzyme from *Escherichia coli* an Sadenosylmethionine radical enzyme were also solved by X ray crystallography providing the first structure of an activase from this family of enzymes These structures revealed the enzyme s active site and the residues involved in binding and orienting substrate for hydrogen atom abstraction Comparison of the structures of the substrate free and substrate bound forms of the enzyme identified a conformational change associated with substrate binding Detailed analyses of the structure of pyruvate formatelyase activating enzyme were carried out to provide insight into catalysis These structures were also analyzed in comparison with other S adenosylmethionine radical enzyme structures to more clearly understand the structural basis for reactivity in this superfamily

Insights on Iron-sulfur Cluster Assembly Donor Proteins Eric Michel Dizin,2008 Abstract Iron sulfur clusters are an important class of prosthetic group involved in electron transfer enzyme catalysis and regulation of gene expression Their biosynthesis requires a complex machinery located within the mitochondrion since free iron and sulfide are extremely toxic to the cell This research has focused on the three central proteins dedicated to the assembly a cysteine desulfurase Nfs1 an iron donor protein frataxin and an iron sulfur cluster scaffold protein Isu1 Human Nfs1 a PLP dependent enzyme catalyzes the decomposition of cysteine to alanine and forms a persulfide bond with a conserved cysteine residue To date Nfs1 has only been partially characterized Furthermore its hyperproduction relies on yeast organism *Pichia pastoris* which is cumbersome and leads to quite low yields Therefore we undertook to design a bacterial expression system by cloning and overexpressing the gene in different *E. coli* strain This enabled only a partial characterization of the cysteine desulfurase Besides being an iron donor for iron sulfur cluster assembly frataxin has also been implicated in heme biosynthesis and in iron storage in the mitochondrion with reported ferroxidase activity We decided to further investigate its ability to bind to other metals such as magnesium calcium and zinc and also studied its ferroxidase activity as a mature and as a truncated protein We concluded that frataxin has negligible ferroxidase activity comparable to iron and quite distinct from ferritin Moreover frataxin binds zinc besides iron but with a different stoichiometry
