Prenatal Choroid Plexus Cysts

Neurodevelopmental Follow-up of Children Found to Have Isolated Choroid Plexus Cyst on Prenatal Ultrasound Sarah Chan (Physician), 2013 The purpose of this study was to expand the pilot study that studied the developmental outcome of infants diagnosed with isolated choroid plexus cysts identified during prenatal ultrasounds This study focused on expanding the sample size of the pilot study in particular the population of control patients A retrospective cohort study design was utilized to evaluate the developmental outcome of children prenatally diagnosed with isolated choroid plexus cyst CPC A total of 58 isolated choroid plexus cyst and 27 control cases were enrolled in this study This study did not find a statistical difference in any of the five developmental domains of the Ages and Stages Questionnaire ASQ between the CPC and control groups Additionally adjustment for maternal age and age of child at time of evaluation also did not reveal any association between isolated CPC finding and an abnormal score in any of the five developmental domains on the ASQ There was a statistical difference in the number of children with 2 developmental domains that were either at or below cut off scores with a total of 10 children in the CPC group compared to none in the control group However after adjustment for maternal age and age of child at the time of evaluation there was no significant association between isolated CPC finding and having 2 abnormal developmental domains
