- While the EdD is geared towards individuals looking to put their knowledge into practice, the PhD is primarily focused on conducting research.

PROS AND CONS

Pros

- Promotes critical thinking skills
- Ensures practice is supported by empirical research

Cons

- Students usually attend university out of an interest in becoming practitioners, not researchers.
- Students may graduate without sufficient practical skills.
